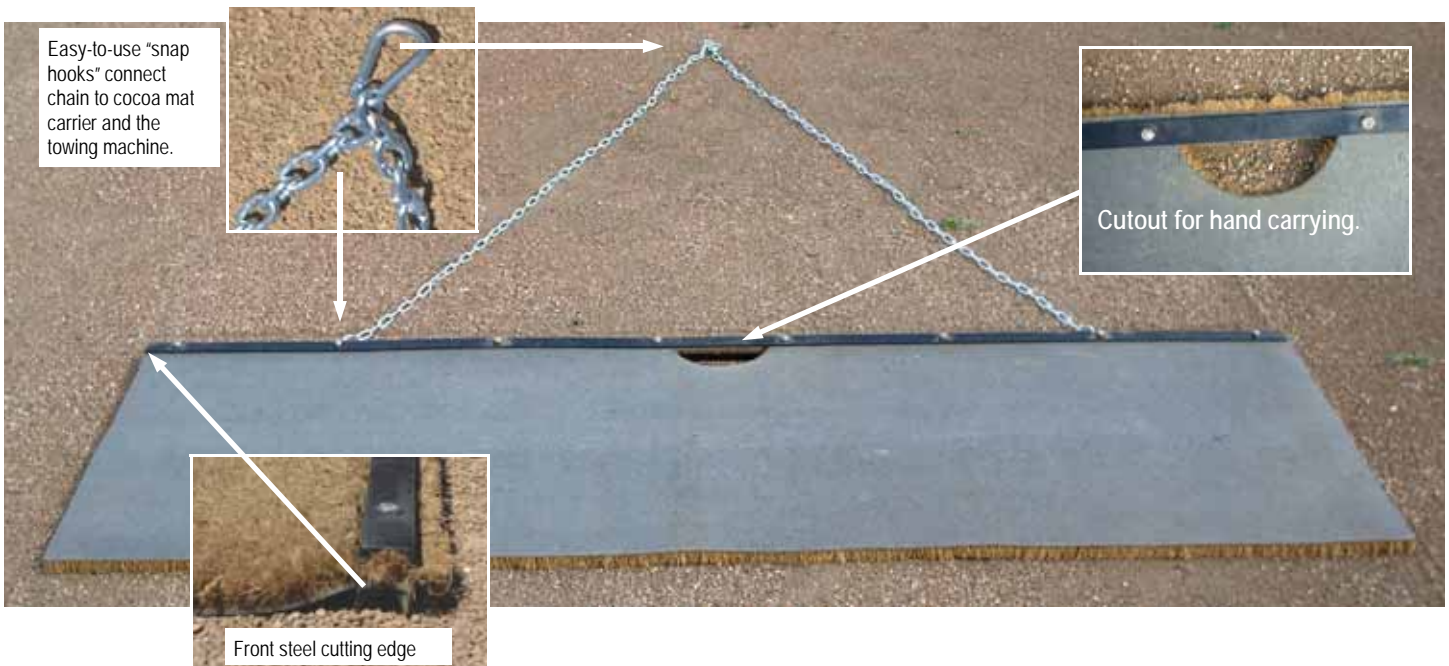


Cocoa Mat Drags

Cocoa Mats are made from 1" high natural cocoa fibers that are attached to a heavy rubber backing. Uses include finishing granular ball fields, breaking up aeration plugs and working in top dressing. The front edge of our cocoa mats are sandwiched between two heavy duty steel channel bars that hold and pull the mat. In the center is a cutout for easy hand carrying. Each comes complete with a heavy duty steel chain and quick clips for towing or pulling by hand. Cocoa mats float over the surface producing a fine finish. Unlike steel drag mats, a cocoa mat displaces much less dirt so there is no pile of dirt when finished, plus they pull easier. The cocoa mats can also be flipped over (rubber side down) so the steel channel along the front edge can be used to shave off minor high spots in the surface.

Advantages of cocoa mats:

- 1) they are lighter and easier to pull than steel drags.
- 2) minimal displacement of surface material (there is very little material piled up when finished dragging).
- 3) less likely to gouge grass turf when turning.

Uses:

- 1) Drag granular surfaces, such as infields, warning tracks, etc.
- 2) Breaking up core aeration plugs in grass turf. They are less likely to gouge the grass when turning.
- 3) Pull over grass turf while adding top dressing to help work in the material.
